Terry Murray has the history of guitar music at his fingertips. He plucks, strums, picks and slides his way through every style imaginable, with his audience clapping, tapping and strumming along. Each show is tailored to audience requirements from beginners to advanced students. A self-taught musician, Terry's performance publicises the virtues of persistence, practise and good humour. A dynamic and professional showman.

THE PERFORMANCE

What do you get when you cross an acoustic, a steel string, an electric and a bass guitar, with a bank of effects pedals and a sequencer? Terry Murray, of course, the guitar supremo with a kaleidoscope of stringed sounds and styles at his fingertips.

From flamenco to rap, classical to rockabilly, this programme traces the origin of the guitar and demonstrates the way in which simple melodies can be dramatically changed by choice of instrument and feel.

Terry invites his audience to supplement his drum machine with basic forms of body percussion, exploring syncopation and rhythm, and guitar players are welcome to bring their instruments as some may be selected to play along.

For high school students, signature licks are included – Jimi Hendrix, Led Zeppelin, Eric Clapton, Deep Purple. All the greats are sampled with the students asked to name the relevant artists.

THE PERFORMER

English born, Terry Murray's musical experience covers all styles and mediums including film, theatre, television and radio. He has toured Europe with The Four Tops, The Temptations and Hot Chocolate and has recorded film scores with the London Symphony Orchestra.

In Australia, Terry has worked with Tom Jones, Jimmy Barnes, Lee Kernagan, Steve Wright, Marcia Hines and Tommy Emmanuel to name just a few. He was Musical Director for "Soulman" and "The Motown Story" for Kinsela's nightclub and has worked with Doug Mulray on 2 MMM and the "Mulray" television show, with Andrew Denton on "Live and Sweaty" and "The Money or the Gun" and has appeared many times on "The Footy Show".

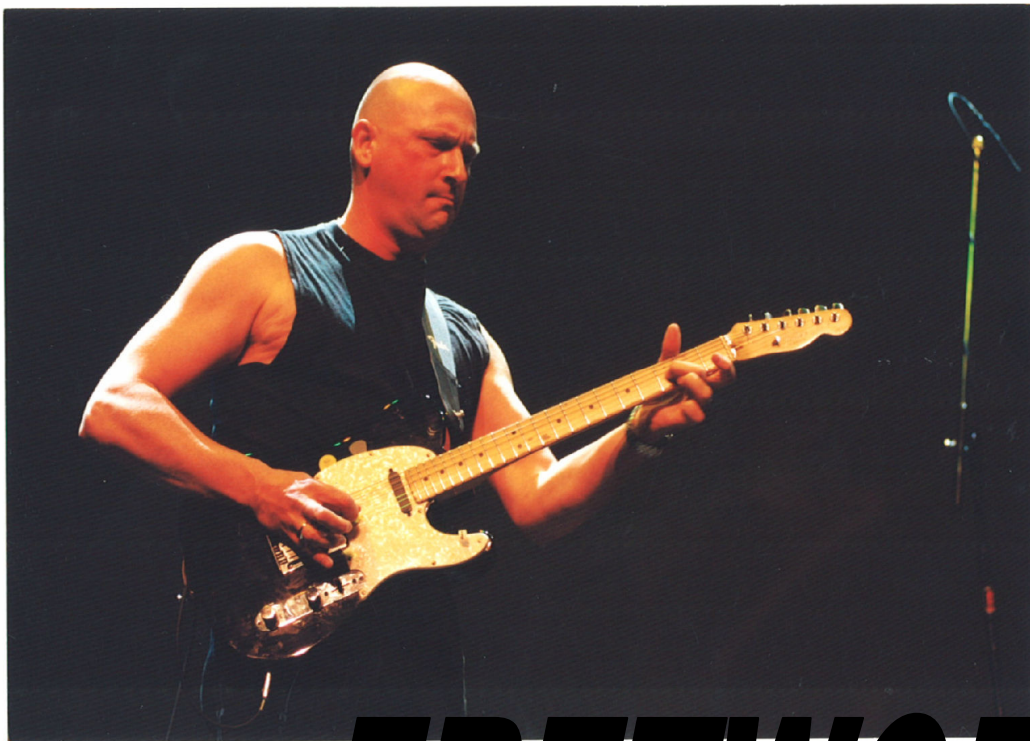
