**THE PERFORMANCE:** Guitar maestro Terry Murray has presented *Fretwork, The history of the guitar* and its sequel *We Will Rock You* to many thousands of students throughout Australia over the past fifteen years. Now he brings you *Young Guitar Heroes* - the prequel for your aspiring guitarists.

With Elvis, The Beatles, Queen, AC/DC and more, Terry Murray takes your students through a whirlwind history of the guitar, stopping off at the classics for some student participation – which of your students can twist and shout?! Throughout the programme students learn where the guitar came from and see how its developments have changed the course of music history.

Terry asks ‘Can children’s classics such as ‘Twinkle Twinkle Little Star’ be transformed into classic rock? With the press of a button the melody is changed step by step with the addition of drums, bass and piano - From nursery rhyme to Heavy Metal!

Using his Roland Sample machine Terry will explain the process of voice sampling, before playing theme songs such as Mission Impossible, X files, 007 and Jaws.

Terry Murray personifies the rock ‘n’ roll guitarist and his love of the instrument and its music makes for a charged performance. An advocate of ‘Practice makes perfect’ Terry will help your students discover that they too can be a ‘Young Guitar Hero’!

**THE PERFORMER:** English born, Terry Murray’s musical experience covers all styles and mediums including film, theatre, television and radio. He has toured Europe with The Four Tops, The Temptations and Hot Chocolate and has recorded film scores with the London Symphony Orchestra.

In Australia, Terry has worked with Tom Jones, Jimmy Barnes, Lee Kernagan, Steve Wright, Marcia Hines and Tommy Emmanuel to name just a few. He was Musical Director for “Soulman” and “The Motown Story” for Kinsela’s nightclub and has worked with Doug Mulray on 2 MMM and the “Mulray” television show, with Andrew Denton on “Live and Sweaty” and “The Money or the Gun” and has appeared many times on “The Footy Show”.

Terry is a member of the thrashgrass band “THE FARGONE BEAUTIES” who in 2006 headlined the Gympie Music Muster and released a CD/DVD. In 2006 Terry returned to London for a season at the legendary Ronnie Scott’s Jazz Club.
