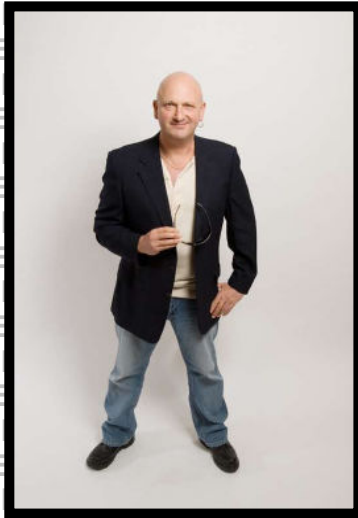

## The evolution of the electric guitar

### THE PERFORMANCE

Guitar maestro Terry Murray has presented *Fretwork, The history of the guitar* to many thousands of students throughout Australia over the past fifteen years. As a follow on to *Fretwork*, Terry has now devised a more focused programme tracking the impact of the electric guitar on rock and roll and popular contemporary music.

Where did rock and roll come from and what social changes occurred to make it possible? Terry will start the journey with a look at how Afro-American blues, gospel, jazz and country fused to become the foundation of a style to be known as 'rock and roll'. This style was cemented in the 50's by artists such as Eddie Cochrane, Chuck Berry and Elvis and further developed by The Beatles and The Rolling Stones with The British Invasion of the 1960's. The heavy metal experience in the 70's introduced Led Zeppelin, Deep Purple, Black Sabbath and our local boys AC/DC. The 80's heralded another change with bands such as Nirvana and Metallica capturing the sound. 'Typical' riffs of the 50's, 60's, 70's and 80's will be played using all the tricks of the trade to show how distinctive each style was.

Terry Murray personifies the rock 'n' roll guitarist and his love of the instrument and its music makes for a charged performance.

### THE PERFORMER

English born, Terry Murray's musical experience covers all styles and mediums including film, theatre, television and radio. He has toured Europe with The Four Tops, The Temptations and Hot Chocolate and has recorded film scores with the London Symphony Orchestra.

In Australia, Terry has worked with Tom Jones, Jimmy Barnes, Lee Kernagan, Steve Wright, Marcia Hines and Tommy Emmanuel to name just a few. He was Musical Director for "Soulman" and "The Motown Story" for Kinsela's nightclub and has worked with Doug Mulray on 2 MMM and the "Mulray" television show, with Andrew Denton on "Live and Sweaty" and "The Money or the Gun" and has appeared many times on "The Footy Show".

Terry is a member of the thrashgrass band "THE FARGONE BEAUTIES" who in 2006 headlined the Gympie Music Muster and released a CD/DVD. In 2006 Terry returned to London for a season at the legendary Ronnie Scott's Jazz Club.
