#### *\*On A Far, Far Away Mountain... - Bronwyn Vaughan*

So begins the storyteller's tale of her journey over the misty mountains, the people, animals and creatures she meets and the stories she hears on her way. The show is based on contemporary and traditional children's stories from the Himalayan region and includes tales from Tibet, China, Nepal and India. Told in a highly theatrical storytelling style, the show uses beautifully designed and crafted puppets, props, sets and costumes, a wondrous array of exotic musical instruments and culturally inspired movement, music, song and dance.
